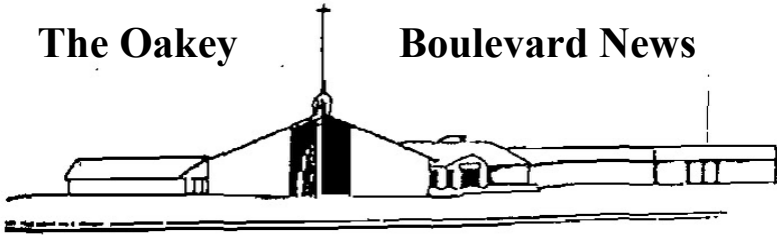

Today's society in America will decry this statement. It may even be challenged in court as discrimination, or worse, hate speech. God is love (1 John 4:8) and this is God's speech, not hate speech. Prophets

Micah 5:2 foretells the birthplace of the Messiah. The place appointed and foretold five hundred years before the event was Bethlehem, little Bethlehem of Judea. How could the birthplace of any individual be foretold so precisely and so far in advance except it be by inspiration? God breathed the words through the writer's instrument (verbal inspiration) by knowing it in advance (Omniscience). It is impossible for God to lie (Hebrews 6:18). But what does this prophecy prove even if fulfilled? One major thing is that it absolutely teaches you, if it was fulfilled, that the Book of Mormon is not a sacred book, but a book of error! The Book of Mormon teaches that Jerusalem was the birthplace of Jesus and the Bible prophesied little Bethlehem of Judea. Both cannot be right in the same sense and at the same time, though both could be wrong and therefore both books would be false! I wonder which is right or even if both are wrong? (cont.) bosom. Psalm 120 teaches that the lying tongue is the state of the art tool of conflict. It is called the sharp arrow of the warrior. A warrior is one who is at war. Some warriors are accomplished and have no scruples about sitting across one table and making a statement and later denying it across another table with the same individual. How do you resolve this if you are for peace? There is no resolution. There is only distress. What is one to do in such a case? Verse one says, "In my distress I called upon the Lord..." The second point made is that you must be able to say, "I am for peace" (vs.7). Randy Mabe

Gospels

Where was Jesus born? Well the Christmas song says, "O Bethlehem, O Bethlehem..." But Christmas songs will not of themselves save you because they are not inspired by God, though these songs may inspire men (pun intended!) The question we always need to ask is, "What does the Bible say?" When we look for current law we ask, "What does the New Testament say?" In Matthew 2:5-6 we read the answer: It is little Bethlehem of Judea. And it references the prophet Micah to tell us that the prophecy was fulfilled precisely as stated five hundred years before. You might also remember that God had allowed no prophet to speak at all for over four hundred years. The Bible is right, and always will be. The Book of Mormon is wrong and uninspired of God and always will be. We also learned that the fulfillment of prophecy points out Jesus to be the anointed one, the Christ. Follow Him! Randy Mabe

History

This same Jesus promised to build His one church (Matthew 16:16-19).
