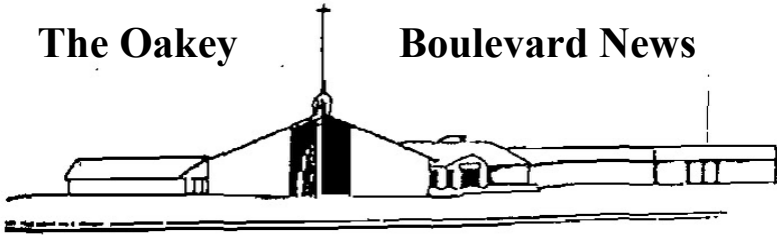

Pentateuch

The Book of Deuteronomy covers about thirty days in time in contrast to about fifteen hundred years time in Genesis. There are only sixteen chapters difference in length. Deuteronomy is the second reading of the Law. It was the fortieth year, eleventh month and first day of the wilderness trek that Moses again read all of God's commandments to Israel. They were in Moab and the scriptures say that Moses explained the law to them. He started the narrative in a good time for Israel. It was before being sent to the desert to wander forty years. Prophets

Jeremiah 23 starts off with a warning and a promise. Jeremiah was God's prophet and his message was true - then an today. Shepherds are leaders among God's people. They are to tend, feed and protect the people of God from all that is worldly. The shepherds of Jeremiah's day had led them into apostasy and false ways. Some by negligence and some by intention (Notice the people were 'driven' away). Two things should comfort you as God's child in this text. Jesus was coming and good shepherds would be raise dup to feed, tend and protect God's people. Also God said He would "attend to the false prophets for their evil doings...". Each Christian must be responsible for their studies and for who they follow. But the false shepherd that leads God's people away will also meet God. Randy L. Mabe

PSALMS

Gospels

Remember that God promised Jeremiah to send the Branch and raise up good shepherds for His people? He did not promise a Golden Age where nothing molested.
