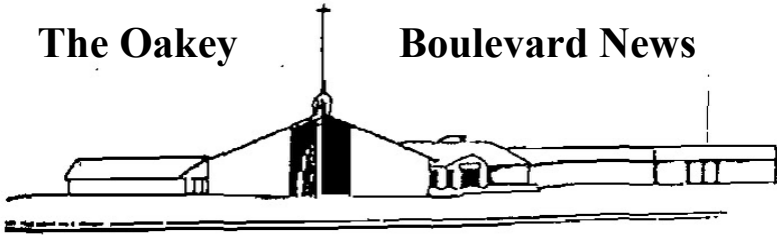

## **BIBLE CAMP**

Young people love to go to Bible Camp. Guess what? I did too - that's right about 50 years ago I was a Bible Camper! I still remember many of the events, feelings, studies and just good times experienced there. Guess what? If you live long enough you will too!

We choose to drive all the way to Oakhurst, California (10 miles south of the South entrance into Yosemite National Park) because of the program there. First, this week of camp (the week that always contains July 4th) is overseen by the elders of the Visalia Church of Christ, a sound congregation in doctrine and deeds. Next, the director for over 30 years has been Jack Stewart, preacher for the East Bakersfield Church of Christ. He is very good at directing a great Bible Camp. Also, the program is full of Bible Study, as it ought to be. Then there is plenty of fun to be had by all. The number in camp increases each year. This year there will be almost 200!

The theme this year is "Let Your Light Shine". All the lessons will be geared to this theme. It will be a worthwhile study for the youngest to the oldest. Each day there will be about four hours of study time on these lessons. The teachers keep the lessons moving and participatory. The students have books that have 'homework' and 'fill in the blanks'.

Worship on Sunday calls for 'dress up' clothes that show

(cont.) respect and reverence. The young people are used many times through the week to conduct various aspects of worship. They learn to lead and to serve.

The camp facilities are superb. This camp has been owned for over 50 years and it has been improved each year by donations of labor, money and love. The kitchen and dining facilities are great and that is where the GREAT food comes from too! The daily menu has been given lots of thought and includes all food groups with plenty of fruit.

Sporting events, arts and crafts, quiet time, free time, snack time, and campfire helps fill each day. The camp fire really has no “fire” but plenty of participation events, jokes, skits, songs that keep everyone entertained and engaged in a wholesome way.

We will be using a charter bus again this year for transportation. It is very expensive but affords us a measure of safety that is worth the expense. We may not be able to use the charter bus next year if our budget does not improve. Give a little extra each week if you want to keep the bus. We must start hitting the budget goal each week if we are to accomplish this task. Remember to arrive at the building at 5:00 AM 3 July so we can organize, load, and leave by 6:00 AM. We will return 10 July in the late afternoon. Parents and guardians will receive a phone call about 45 minutes before we arrive at the building. Be available for the phone call and quickly get to the building to take your children home. Everyone will be tired and will want to go home immediately.

PLEASE, remember to take your BIBLE to BIBLE CAMP 8^)). Take a godly, happy attitude that will last all week. Take only authorized things. Have fun but be orderly, attentive, and obedient from 5:00 AM 3 July through late afternoon 10 July - “...submitting to one another in the fear of God” (Ephesians 5:21).
